At Red Dirt Productions, we love to travel, and we love to eat.

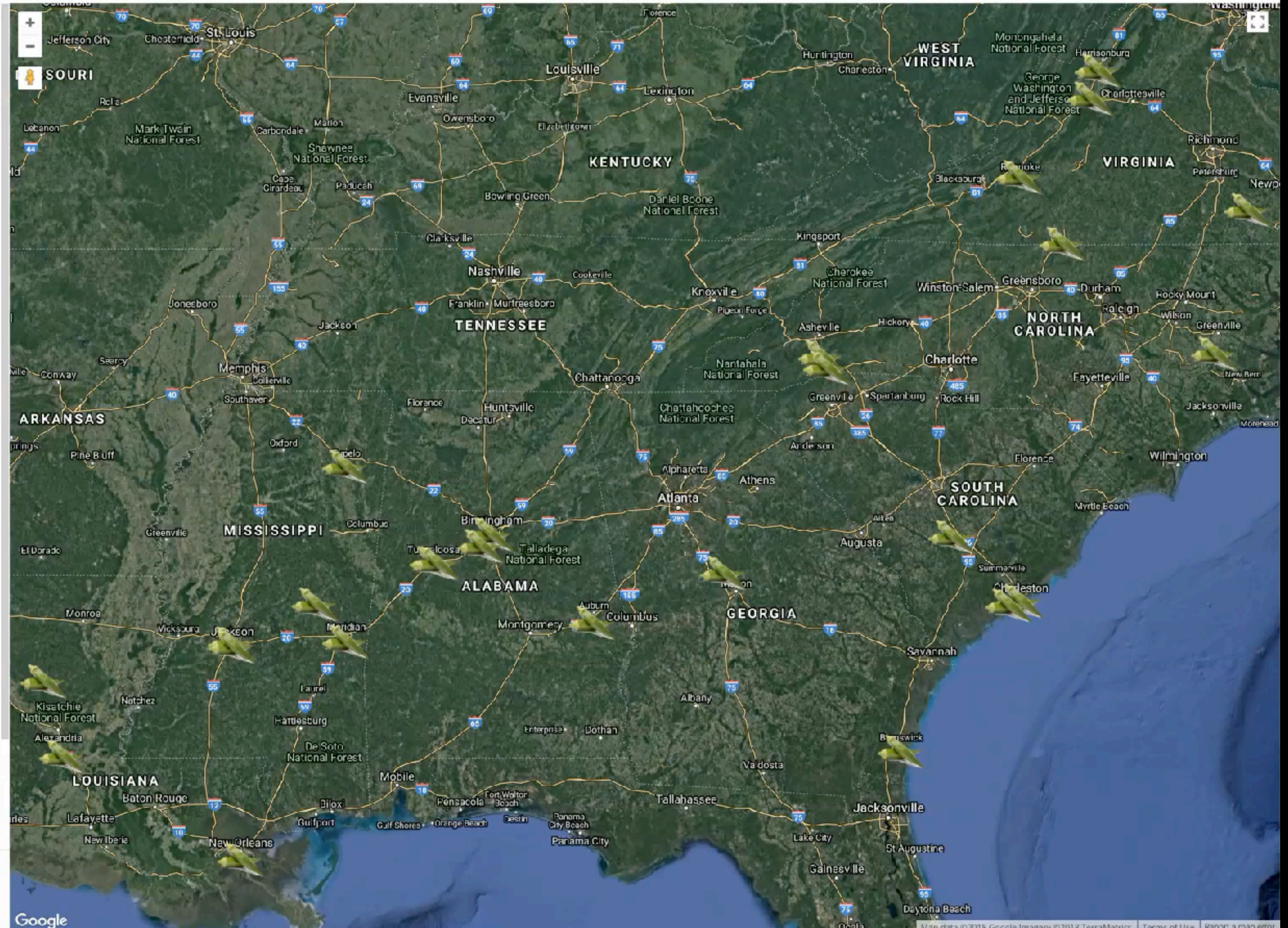
While southern food is having a moment, our favorite old school formica table restaurants with their lunch plate specials are getting harder and harder to come by. These are the places we are drawn to—where the tea is sweet, the menus handwritten and the staff glad to see you.

This map and list are unsystematic as well as unscientific. Most are decidedly old school "meat and three" restaurants whose offerings depend on both the season of the year and local inclinations. You will find neither shrimp and grits, nor chicken and waffles on their menus.

One establishment we included solely because its view of the Black Warrior River has one of the most soul-soothing scenes we know. Another makes a mean ice cream soda. At some — Bully's in Jackson and the Brown Derby Number 2 in Orangeburg for example—every bite assures you the pot was stirred with loving attention.

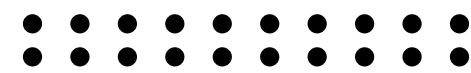

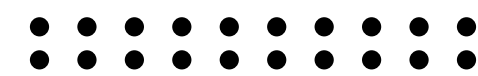
